You are invited to participate in "ART IN THE CLOSE", a one-day art sale at St. Michaels Church in Bristol to be held Saturday, June 4, 2011 (rain date: June 11). There will be 28 artists displaying on the iron fence around St. Michael's and 7 artists in the close. Each artist will be assigned an 8 foot section of fence to display their artwork. A 10x10 foot tent may be used in the close, but no tents are permitted on the public sidewalk. Please bring clear plastic to cover your artwork in case of summer showers and a folding chair to sit in. Feel free to look at the fence in advance and be creative in preparing a way to display your work on the day of the show.

Eligibility:

Artists in all fine arts disciplines are welcome to apply. Artists agree to be present during all show hours. No commercial agents, dealers or manufacturers may enter. Send two photographs of your work with the application with a SASE for return of photos. All work must be original. We have the right to remove any artwork we find inappropriate for this public event.

1) The event will be held SATURDAY, JUNE 4, 2011 (rain date: June 11) open to the public from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Set up and check in time will begin at 8 a.m. After unloading, artists may park in the municipal parking lots on Court Street, diagonally across from the church, or on Thames Street behind the church.

2) Your application must be received with an entry fee of \$35.00. Checks should be made payable to St. Michael's Church with "Art in the Close" in the memo line. Applications and checks should be mailed to: St. Michaels Church, Attn: Art in the Close, 399 Hope Street, Bristol, RI 02809

3) Mail in Deadline for Applications: on or before May 1, 2011.

We will email your acceptance into the show along with the number of the space assigned to you on a first come first served basis. Insurance is the responsibility of the artist.

4) You must have a retail sales permit from the State of RI to display at this event. If you do not have one, you may get one through the state of RI Department of Revenue, Division of taxation, or you may also get a temporary sales permit at a cost of \$10.00 on the day of the event. All permits must be on display at each vendor booth. Sales tax money collected during the event must be handed in with a copy of your permit at the end of the day.
